General Guidelines

All submissions to IWAC must meet the following minimum requirements in order to be considered for acceptance to the workshop:

- IWAC is soliciting papers for Academic and Interchange Tracks. Authors may choose the appropriate Track depending on the objective.
- **Academic Track:** Academic research submissions
- **Interchange Track:** Non-academic presentations such as introduction of a project/product, proposal for aircraft operations/supporting technologies etc...
- All papers must be written in English.
- Papers must be submitted electronically via the Workshop's Online Submission System <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=iwac2022>

Academic Track – Paper Submission

- Paper selection in the Academic Track will be based on full paper submissions which must **NOT exceed eight A4 size pages** including all text, figures and references. Any submission exceeding the permitted length will be rejected.
The first page must include the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), and the email address of the corresponding author.
Detailed format information is available in [Microsoft Word format](#). ([Latex format](#) will be available soon).
- Papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word format or Portable Document Format (PDF) before the deadline. Note that the online paper submission system will not allow any submission after the deadline.
- Papers must be scientifically rigorous and the content should be original and previously unpublished work, including proper description on the methodology and findings achieved supported with sufficient results.

Academic Track – Selection Process

- Papers will be carefully reviewed by the Technical Program Committee (TPC). Each paper will receive a notification of acceptance/rejection with feedback on the review results.
- Authors of accepted papers must submit the final camera-ready version with necessary changes requested by the TPC.
- Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give an oral / poster presentation at the workshop.
- Best Paper Award and Best Student Paper Award will be selected from the papers submitted to the Academic Track.
- Students can submit their papers under the Student Paper category, provided that the First Author must be a student pursuing an academic degree at the time of initial submission.
- Accepted papers will be published in the workshop proceedings and planned to be submitted for inclusion in the J-Stage database (DOI assigned and indexed in Google Scholar).
- Selected high-quality papers will be nominated for the “Transactions of the Japan Society for Aeronautical and Space Sciences” (2020 Journal Impact Factor: 0.882) published by the Japan Society for Aeronautical and Space Sciences (JSASS). Candidate papers will be re-reviewed according to JSASS guidelines. Note that the publication fee of accepted papers will be paid from this workshop.

Interchange Track – Paper Submission

- Paper selection in the Interchange Track will be based on submissions which must **NOT exceed one A4 size page**. Any submission exceeding the permitted length will be rejected.
The first page must include the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), and the email address of the corresponding author.
Detailed format information is available in [Microsoft Word format](#). ([Latex format](#) will be available soon).
- Papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word format or Portable Document Format (PDF) before the deadline. Note that the online paper submission system will not allow any submission after the deadline.

Interchange Track – Selection Process

- Papers will be reviewed by the Technical Program Committee (TPC). Each paper will receive a notification of acceptance/rejection.
- Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give an oral / poster presentation at the workshop.
- Accepted papers will be published in the workshop proceedings.

Instructions for Accepted Papers

- Note that the information provided with your submission will be used to automatically generate the table of contents of the proceedings, authors index, and the final program of the workshop. Therefore, make sure to re-check the provided details are accurate.
- Authors of accepted papers must submit the final camera-ready paper by the required deadline through the Online Paper Submission System.
Authors should update the initial submission with the camera-ready version.
- Authors must attach a copy of the signed Copyright Transfer Agreement when submitting the camera-ready paper.
